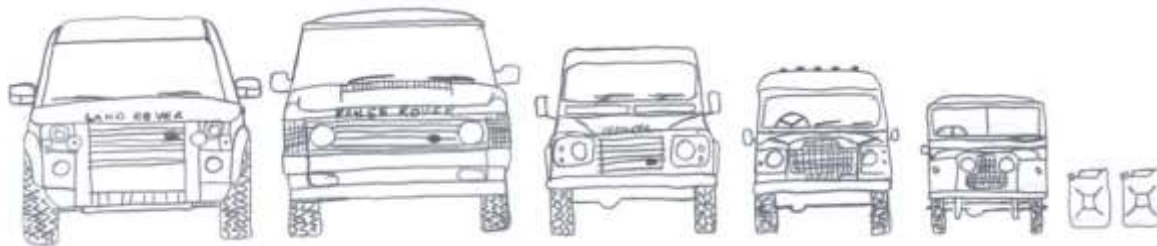

Directions:

From Johannesburg:

There are a number of ways to get to Zwartkops from the Johannesburg area.

The most common way is past Kyalami – travel in a generally Northerly direction along the R55 towards Pretoria West. (It is approximately 21 km from Kyalami to Zwartkops) This road can become congested on big international race days. From Johannesburg, get onto the N14 (Krugersdorp Highway) and head Eastwards. Take the R55/ Pretoria West off-ramp and turn left towards Pretoria West. Travel in a generally Northerly direction on the R55 and you will reach Zwartkops Raceway on your left.

From East Rand:

From the R21 take the Solomon Mahlangu off ramp – travel Westwards on the M10 until the R55. Turn right into the R55 and Zwartkops is on your left + 3 km.

From Pretoria:

Take Mitchell Street under the subway past the Old Power Station (on the left). Turn left into Quagga Road and travel Southwards past Laudium until you reach Zwartkops on your right.

We meet at the entrance of The Eiland Holiday Resort and the convoy will depart at 14:00 sharp on the afternoon of the 5th of August. We will then drive to the Klein Letaba River where we will camp in the river. It is ± 2 hours' drive from The Eiland, with the last hour and a half off road and to ensure that we have daylight left to put up camp, we will NOT wait for anyone. We will follow the Klein Letaba River for the next two days up to Giyani, from there we will drive back to the Molototsi River. The last day will be spent in the Molototsi River with our last night's camp on the confluence of the Letaba and the Molototsi rivers.

This will be bush camping with no facilities provided. Only those who met the above requirements need to book.

Unfortunately, the number of vehicles will be limited to 14 excluding that of our guide and therefore you have to book your place with our Club Administrator as soon as possible. A non-refundable deposit will be payable on booking, to cover some of the guide's fuel expenses.

Long Trip to Angola

We are planning a 20 day trip through Angola from September 10 to 29, 2016, a four week trip overall from Gauteng. Our intentions are to explore the South West corner of Angola from Ruacana, up north towards Luanda and then back down along the Atlantic coast to the mouth of the Cunene River on the border with Namibia. In between we will explore many historical places and points of interest. Amongst the possible highlights will be the Leba Pass, a camp over at Flamingo Lodge, a drive along Doodsakker to Foz do Cunene and a drive back to Ruacana through the Iona National Park (Parque Nacional do Iona), the largest national park in Angola. Since there are limited camping facilities along the route we will be bush camping most of the time with maybe one or two more luxury camping stops where we can find them.

Based on the advice we have received we will have a guide throughout. Since we will be bush camping, and don't have to worry about accommodation costs, his cost will be the major cost which will be offset by the saving in accommodation. For those possibly concerned about the route to Foz do Cunene via Doodsakker there is an alternative route we can take. However when we asked our guide about how safe it was to travel Doodsakker his answer was "look at the sea on the day, it will tell you!"

All is welcome to spent Saturday evening around a camp fire on the banks of the Olifant's River, a bag of wood per vehicle should be sufficient. Sunday will be at your own leisure. .
Please be aware that we camp next the Olifants River and you will have to take protective measures against mosquitoes.
