## FINANCIAL MATTERS.

Dear club members.

For next year's fees the committee debated the increase in the fee and a proposal was presented by me to the committee. This proposal was accepted and the new fees are herewith announced. The club is increasing its fees in line with inflation. We have kept the increase to around 5% in line with the current CPIX rate (Consumer Price Index). The club is as any organisation susceptible to increases in our costs and we also have to be prudent and budget for increases in costs. For clarity and to see that we are still offering a good value to our members I have added a matrix of the increases. The new fees are marked in yellow.

Other activities offered are mountain biking, hiking, birding and fly fishing and for the kids Tiffindell offers mountain boarding and grass skiing.





Booking is essential as primary school children's gifts have to be ordered. **No booking No gift.**


The program for the weekend is as follows:
